

Form CRS Customer Relationship Summary, March 1, 2025

GPM Growth Investors, Inc. (GPM) is an Investment Adviser registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission.

Brokerage and investment advisory services and fees differ, and it is important for *retail investors* to understand the differences. Free and simple tools are available to research firms and financial professionals at Investor.gov/CRS, which also provides educational materials about broker-dealers, investment advisers, and investing.

What investment services and advice can you provide me?

GPM is an employee-owned investment advisory firm based in Bloomfield Hills, MI and founded in 1993. We invest money for a diverse client base and provide financial planning. Our goal is to preserve and grow capital for clients and sustain long-term relationships through transparency, open communication, and satisfactory investment returns. We offer **discretionary** investment management services to individuals, profit sharing plans, trusts, estates, charitable organizations, and small businesses. We also provide individual clients with well-tailored wealth management guidance and financial planning that includes preparation of long-term projections that put retirement planning in clear focus. **Our standard minimum is \$1,000,000 for accounts that invest primarily in individual securities and \$100,000 for ETF-based accounts.** Exceptions to these minimums can be made.

The foundation of our investment approach is the ownership of approximately 30 high-quality, historically successful U.S. based growth companies. Our *Long-Term Growth portfolios* normally invest 100% in stocks. *Balanced portfolios* hold stocks and bonds for a more conservative approach. Our team members invest in our model securities alongside our clients.

Account holdings are monitored daily. All model positions are regularly reviewed based on the outlook for the stock and bond market and the individual securities held, and to determine if holdings continue to be consistent with the objectives of client accounts. If it is determined that a particular security should be added to or removed from the accounts, each account will be reviewed for inclusion in a block trade for which an order will be entered. This is part of our standard service.

What fees will I pay?

Our firm's only compensation is the fee we charge, which is expressed as a percentage of the assets we manage for you. Advisory and portfolio management fees are billed quarterly in advance and are deducted from your account. Our standard annual portfolio management fee is 1.00% of the first \$1,000,000, plus 0.85% above \$1,000,000.

- You will incur certain additional incidental expenses imposed by our custodian such as fees if you request a wire transfer.
- o If your account holds mutual funds and/or exchange traded funds (ETFs), you will also incur internal management fees for such funds.
- We endeavor to keep such additional incidental expenses to a minimum and we do not receive any part of these fees and costs.

Our investment process is disciplined and fundamentally based with a healthy respect for risk. Our advice is holistic and tailored to you and your peace of mind. We listen and learn. 	Over time, growth in your advisory accounts can come from reinvested income, market value gain and additional deposits. As such, GPM's fee increases and decreases with a corresponding change in account value.
